

## Buck Lake Spring Sling 2022 Player Handbook

### General Information

- All parking will be on the soccer field (see map below)
- If there are any disputes on a call, play it out both ways (call a provisional) and record both scores. The dispute will be handled by one of the tournament directors.
- Please maintain a decent pace of play. If a disc is lost, there is a 3-minute clock to find it. If it is still not found, the player throws a shot from previously agreed-upon location with a 1-stroke penalty.
- PDGA Live Scoring should be used for keeping score. Access this by going to <https://www.pdga.com/scores> and using code "buck". It's best to have two people keep score so any discrepancies are immediately noticed and can be corrected. This app will also show OB rules for each hole.
- All asphalt on the course is **OB** unless specified. Any **OB** is played where the disc was last in bounds with a one-stroke penalty.
- The bottom of the holding pond (that is mainly dirt and flat ground) near holes 10, 11 and 12 is an **OB hazard for only MA1, MA2, MA3, MA4, MA40 and MJ18**. For any hazard on the course, the next shot is thrown where the disc lies with a one-stroke penalty.

### Hole Rules

- Hole 1 – Mando (One Way sign) is to the right of tree. If miss mando, proceed to drop zone with a one-stroke penalty. The asphalt driveway and beyond are OB.
- Hole 2 – Mando (One Way sign) is to the left of tree. If disc doesn't end up past the mando on drive, proceed to drop zone with a one-stroke penalty. Take 2 meters relief from Pedrick Road for safety reasons. The asphalt driveway in front of the tee pad is an OB river.
- Hole 3 – The asphalt driveway in front of the tee pad is an OB river.
- Hole 4 – The asphalt driveway to the right of the fairway and beyond is OB.
- Holes 5-6 - No Mandos or OBs.
- Hole 7 – Any asphalt is OB as well as grass area behind island where trash cans enclosure is located.
- Hole 7a – Asphalt on left of fairway and behind basket and beyond is OB. Inside trashcan storage area
- Hole 8 – No Mando.
- Hole 9 – Mando (One Way sign) is to the right of the tree. If miss mando, proceed to drop zone with a one-stroke penalty. Asphalt to left of fairway and beyond is OB
- Hole 10 – Mando (One Way sign) is to the left of tree. If miss mando, proceed to drop zone with a one-stroke penalty. See general rules for OB.
- Hole 11 – No Mando. See general rules for OB.
- Hole 12 – No Mando. The holding pond closest to the basket is safe. See general rules for OB.

The tournament will be 2 rounds. First round will be 26 holes (except for FA3/FA4/FJ15/MJ10 who'll play 13 holes both rounds). The second round is 13 holes for all divisions.

### Hole 12 variances by division:

- MA1 and MA2 will throw from the back pad (490 ft)
- MA40/MA3/MA4/MJ18 will throw from the front pad (400 ft)
- FA3/FA4/FJ15/MJ10 will throw from in front of the first set of bushes (230 feet)
